### President's Message

Longtime members of the Backenstoss Family Association of America will no doubt notice the date of this year's reunion is a departure from our family tradition. The Backenstoss reunion has usually been held on the first Sunday in August. However, this year, in order to reserve the picturesque Gring's Mill Recreation Area, we have scheduled our reunion for Sunday, July 31. Gring's Mill is located at 2083 Tulpehocken Road; Reading, PA, 19610, directly opposite the Penn State Berks Campus. This edition of our family newsletter will also be a departure from previous newsletters in that it will primarily display photographs from our 2015 reunion at Hunsicker's Grove in Mertztown, PA. Family members who attend our reunions always enjoy meeting relatives from the far flung branches of our family tree and hearing stories of how our forefathers established themselves in various locales in the United States and other countries.

Speaking of our family tree, I am happy to report that officers of our organization are hard at work establishing a genealogical website that will display our published family history. The Backenstoss genealogy has been painstakingly recorded in four hardbound volumes published in 1949, 1972, 1993 and 2002. These editions have become treasured heirlooms for many B.F.A. members. The books are no longer in print, but transferring the Backenstoss genealogy to a website will make our history available to current and future generations. As might be imagined, this is a formidable task. However, real progress is being made, and a report on this project will be part of this summer's reunion agenda. The B.F.A. is also interested in obtaining any copies of our histories that may be available, particularly the 1993 history that is our "gold standard" edition.

As you view the photographs on the following pages, you will note a number of current officers and directors are identified by name and genealogical classification as found in our printed histories. The classification system at first appears complicated, but is really quite logical. In my case, as you will see on Page 4, I am a descendant of the third of Hans Ulrich Backenstoss's children who survived to adulthood and emigrated to America in 1743. Therefore, my classification begins with "A3." In the 2nd generation, I am the descendant of the fourth child, therefore my next classification is B4. This format continues through the generations and, as I am of the 8th generation in my line and the oldest of two siblings, my personal classification is H1. My younger sister is H2, and my three children are I1, I2 and I3.

It is my sincere hope that next year's President's Message will contain instructions on how to access our completed genealogical website. That is a challenging goal, but it may well be within our grasp. Thank you for your continued support, and I hope to see you at our Gring's Mill reunion on July 31!
